

NEW YEAR'S DAY BEGINNING ANEW CEREMONY

WHEN: **Thursday, January 1st, 2026**—9:50am – 12:00pm
(***Optional potluck lunch from 12:00 – 1:00pm; **details are below** – Let's celebrate together  ***)

Please arrive at the church between 9:50 and 9:55am to prepare for a 10:00am start of the ceremony.

WHERE: St. Paul's United Methodist Church—4215 Grinnell Ave. / Boulder, CO 80305
(on the NE corner of Grinnell and Gillaspie in south Boulder; for directions, please see church website.)

WHAT: The Beginning Anew ceremony was created by Buddhist teacher Thich Nhat Hanh as a way to review our past experiences, learn from them, and move forward with a clear, strong intention to live an awakened life. This modified version of the ceremony begins with a forty minute period of silent sitting meditation and continues with a series of readings, reflections, and statements of intention. While some of the language is specific to the Buddhist tradition, the ceremony is universal in the way it highlights our innate human capacity for renewal. In that sense, it has meaning for people who identify with a wide variety of faith traditions as well as those who do not identify with any designated religious or spiritual perspective.
